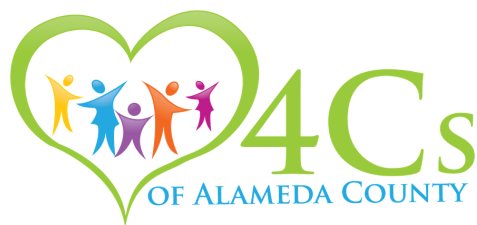




IMPACT REPORT

For 45 years, 4Cs of Alameda County has focused much of our work on equitable access to quality child care. While that mission is still at the heart of what we do, in the past year we have been stretching ourselves and our mission by enhancing our services beyond child care. As you will read in our Program Spotlight, Hayward Promise Neighborhoods programming is back in full swing, with 4Cs at the helm of the network of HPN providers serving families with children ages 0-8. We also opened up two Community "Closets" in our Oakland and Hayward offices providing basic necessities - from diapers and wipes to food and interview clothing. 4Cs continues to support families by offering child care resources, referrals, and payment assistance, trainings and playgroups for parents and child care providers, CalFresh enrollment and re-certification, and free tax preparation and filing through our VITA site. Thank you for supporting 4Cs of Alameda County in the work we do. It is your support, donations, and referrals that allow us to continue to serve our communities. Here's to another 45 years of working together to uplift Alameda County's families.

Community Child Care Council (4Cs) of Alameda County exists to develop and coordinate resources to strengthen families and children.

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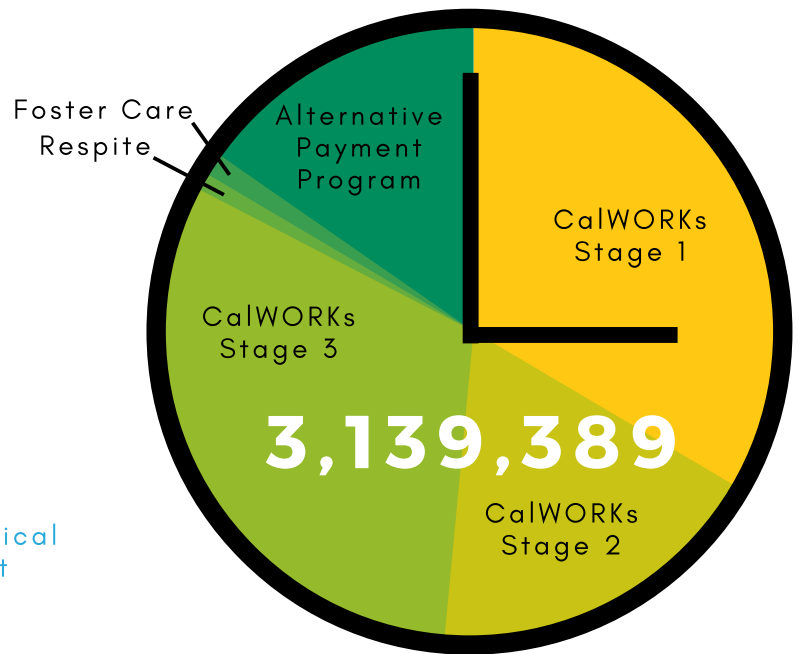

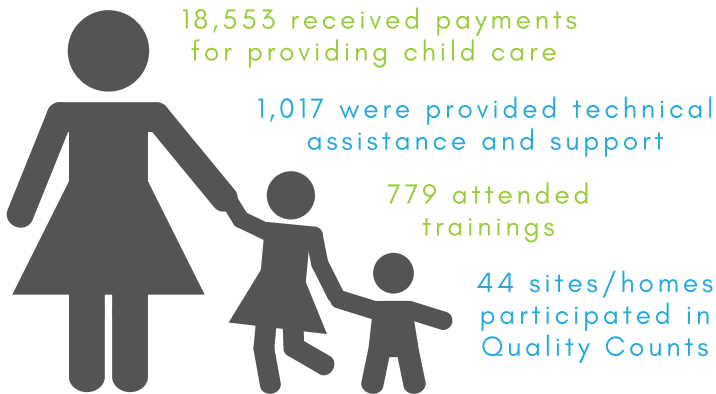
OUR IMPACT

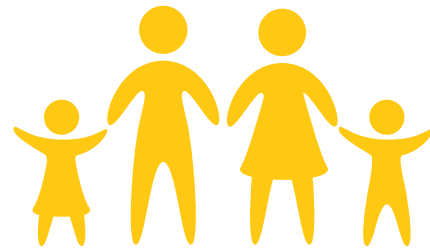

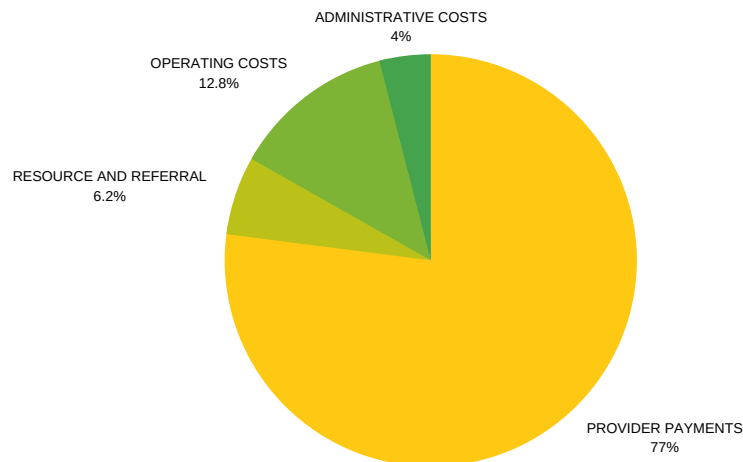

Expenditures by Category

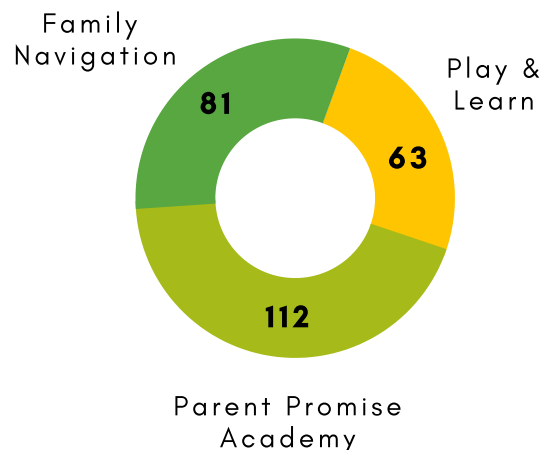


PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT

HAYWARD PROMISE NEIGHBORHOODS

4Cs of Alameda County is proud to be one of the partner agencies of the Hayward Promise Neighborhoods (HPN), a federal grant funded by the Department of Education. HPN programming is offered to residents of the Jackson Triangle and South Hayward Neighborhood footprints and offered to students who attend the HPN target schools. HPN is a collaborative of agencies, organizations, schools, and community members working together to align programs and services to ensure that all children have access to effective schools and strong systems of family and community support.

Children Served by 4Cs' HPN Programs



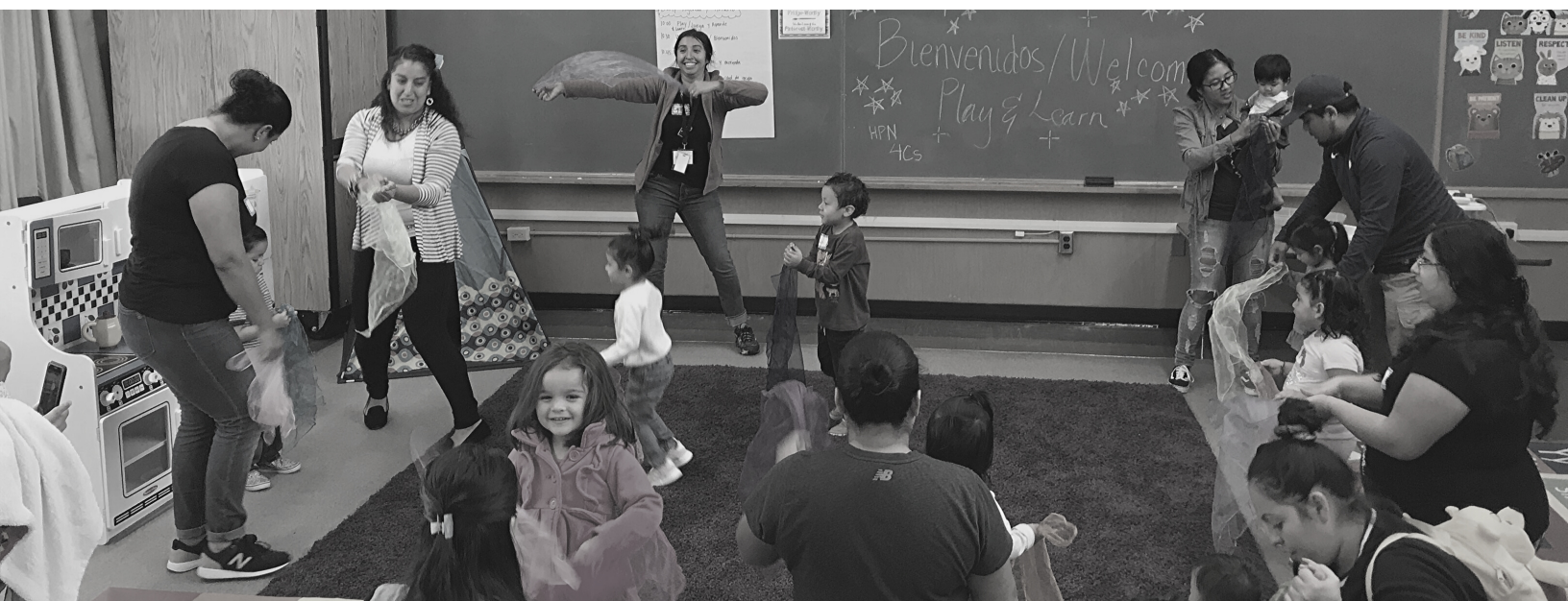
In addition to serving on the HPN Implementation Team and Executive Leadership Team, 4Cs leads four HPN programs to residents with children ages 0-8:

Early Learning Network: Collaborative network of HPN partners focused on improving early learning systems and support for HPN families with children 0-8 years old.

Parent Promise Academy: Comprehensive 10-week parenting education and support program for parents with children ages 0-8 covering topics such as positive behavior, literacy, health, community resources, and more.

Play and Learn: Bilingual (English-Spanish) playgroup program with a trained facilitator for families with children ages 18 months to 4 years old who are not using formal child care or early learning programs.

Navigation: Individualized, strength-based navigation services for families with children 0-8 years. Family navigator will schedule a consultation with families to conduct needs assessment and provide referrals and connections to an array of programs and services.
