4Cs of Alameda County's Emergency Relief Fund

As a trusted family resource agency for almost five decades, 4Cs provides a unique role as a pillar of support for families with young children who contact the agency in times of need. At the onset of the pandemic, 4Cs of Alameda County heard from many in the community about their need specifically for financial supports paying rent, utility bills, and purchasing groceries. With the support of generous sponsors and donors, 4Cs was able to pay almost \$100,000 in grocery gift cards and direct payments to landlords and utility companies between July, 2020 and June, 2021.

\$98,310 IN SUPPORTS PROVIDED TO 308 FAMILIES IN RENTAL ASSISTANCE, BILL PAY, AND GROCERY GIFT CARDS HELPING UPLIFT FAMILIES AND CHILDREN IN ALAMEDA COUNTY.

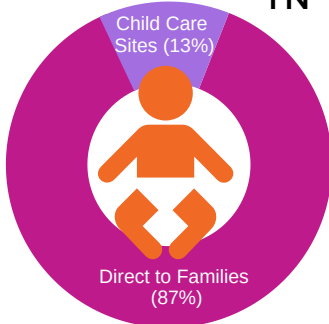
SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

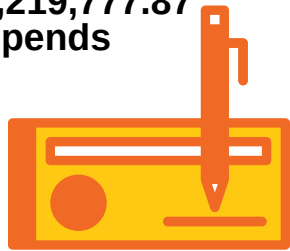

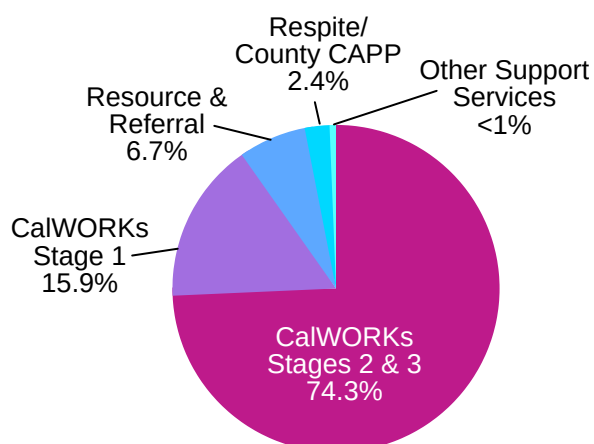

Expenditures By Program

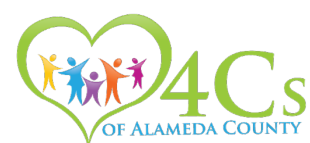


Total Revenue
