INCOME ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES 2023-2024 Effective July 1, 2023

Persons in Household	Annual Income Extremely Low (30%)	Annual Very Low Income (50%)	Annual Low Income (80%)

If you live in Hayward, Fremont or Union City and are income eligible based on the chart above, you may be eligible to participate in 4Cs CCIP program. Contact a staff person for details.

Income Eligibility Requirements

CCIP participants must meet the income guidelines listed above. For <u>each person</u> in the household who is earning an income, we need one of the following forms of income verification:

- Signed and dated IRS 1040 Form from last year (pages 1&2), and schedule C if applicable
- Copy of eligibility certification, e.g., CalFresh, CalWORKS, etc.
- Copy of the most recent income statement from public benefits, e.g., social security, pension, etc.
