**Alameda County Social Services Agency (ACSSA), in partnership with The Spanish Speaking Unity Council, is now recruiting for the CalWORKs Medical Assistant Certification and Job Placement Services Program.** This 10 to 12-month program provides comprehensive Medical Assistant and Phlebotomy training, including classroom instruction and a paid externship at **\$20 per hour**. Participants who successfully complete the program will also receive a **\$2,000 completion stipend**.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Active on CalWORKs with 12+ months remaining time on aid clock.

- Valid authorization to work in the US.



## ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

- Ability to pass a drug screening and background check.
- Current immunization records or willingness to be immunized.
