INCOME SOURCE (REV. JULY 2026)

Total Countable Income is all income of the individuals counted in the family size.

- ☐ Wages, salary, commission, overtime, tips, bonuses, gambling or lottery winnings
- ☐ Cash aid (CalWORKs or TANF)
- ☐ Alimony or child support received
- ☐ Disability or unemployment compensation
- ☐ Survivor and retirement benefits
- ☐ Worker's compensation
- ☐ Adjusted gross income from self-employment
- ☐ Dividends, interest on savings or bonds, income from estate or trusts, net rental income or royalties
- ☐ Inheritance
- ☐ Veteran's pension
- ☐ Migrant, agricultural or seasonal employment
- ☐ Financial assistance received for the care of a child living with an adult who is not the child's biological or adoptive parent
- ☐ Military pay & allowances, including Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH)
- ☐ Other enterprise gain
- ☐ Financial assistance from a friend or relative – *Parent must fill out a Declaration of Income Form*
